











TABLE 6: Clarity and relevance of textual reading material.








TABLE 3: Use of Teaching Aids and ICT to Facilitate Teaching






TABLE 5: Medium of communication used by the Respective Departments




TABLE 6: Whether Students were given the meeting link for online class regularly on time or not




TABLE 7: Whether students were provided with the syllabus of the course at the beginning of the semester or not




TABLE 8: Whether Teachers used PPT presentations during Online Classes




TABLE: 9 Whether Class Tests/Mock Tests were taken online at a regular basis or not




TABLE 10: How the teachers provide feedback on the performance of students.




TABLE 11: Whether sufficient study materials were provided regularly by the Teacher after the completion of each topic




TABLE 12: Coverage of the Syllabus through the online class




TABLE 13: How well did the teachers prepare for class?




TABLE 14: Whether teachers encouraged students to interact during online classes or not










TABLE 18 Frequency of attending Online classes by students




TABLE 19: Overall Learning Experience through Online Platform




TABLE 20: Availability of Online Resources




TABLE 21: Whether students get the Opportunity to Participate in Online Seminars/ Webinars/E-Workshop/E-Conference/Research Projects





TABLE 22: Participation in Co-Academic And Cultural Events
