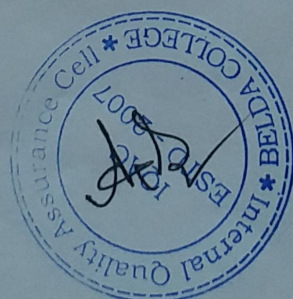


ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON STUDENTS' FEEDBACK : 2021-22

8	To introduce PG Courses	As per the decision taken in the GB meeting held on 06.12.21,



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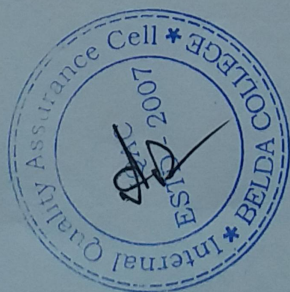
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
ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON TEACHERS' FEEDBACK : 2021-22



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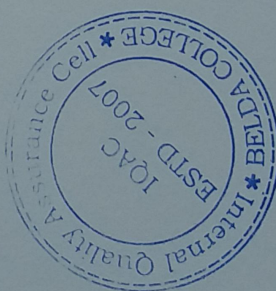

In this academic session, feedback was taken from the Alumni through google form. Total 35 feedback was received from the Alumni. Based on the suggestions received following actions were taken & implemented.

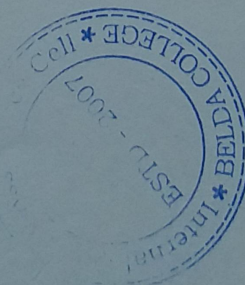

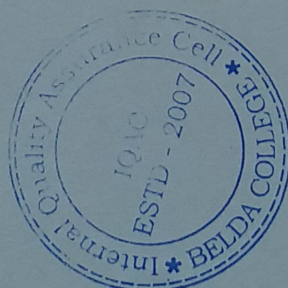
