

<u>Feedback REPORT ON Syllabus and Its Transaction in the Institution and ACTION</u> TAKEN REPORT (2021-22)


Our institute aims to empower our students for succeeding in a changing world to become productive and responsible citizens. For that purpose, The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the College has continuously been working on quality improvement and the betterment of student learning experiences. In order to analyse the lag areas of the college and the scope for further improvement, feedback from various stakeholders have been received through google forms and analyzed critically by the cell. The feedback is taken by the statutory feedback committee. The feedback includes information on pedagogy, discipline and teaching ethics. It also includes views on infrastructure facilities. The feedback was analysed with the help of updated software using some statistical tools and graphs. Concerned teachers were reported about each aspect with areas of improvement. College also regularly takes feedback. In the Four Pillars of Child Centric Education System first and most valuable part is students. The parameters like depth, coverage, applicability, learning value, clarity and relevance of the course along with the relevance of additional source material and the extent of effort required by the students are analysed and evaluated by the students. 


Course delivery by faculty members in the class




Usage of teaching aids and ICT (Information , Communication Technology) in the class by faculty to facilitate teaching




Fairness in the Internal Assessment Processes/ Class test 398 responses

The parameters like depth, coverage, applicability, learning value, clarity and relevance of the course along with the relevance of additional source material and the extent of effort required by the students are analysed and evaluated by the students. Data was collected by sending Google form to the students. Total 399 responses have been collected from the student, out of which 57.6% B. A General, 18% B.A Hons, 14.8% B.Sc Hons and rest of the students are B.com (Hons&Gen), B.Sc General. It was noticed that, B.A. and B.Sc (Hons&Gen) Courses students 90.4% were the major contributories of the survey. Overall 398 students are responses on the questions and most of the students was satisfied more about syllabus, methods of teaching, use of ICT in teaching learning situation, assessment process of the college. On an average 48.7% to 51.3% students are respond on 'Good' whereas 25.9% to 29.6% were much satisfied with the ongoing process. It was also noticed that 1.3% to 2% of students were not satisfied about the syllabus, methods of teaching, use of ICT in the teaching-learning situation, and assessment process of the college. We get few Suggestions from students directly from the various interaction. Few students felt that the syllabus should have more approach to competitive exams. They felt that the curriculum should have a still more practical


approach, especially in science faculty. They suggested that there should be a smart learning environment.

(B) Parents feedback form














(C)Teachers Feedback

After the students teachers are the another most important part of the Education. They play a role as bridge between student and curriculum. They play an important role in designing and




3. Current syllabus is according to the need of the student in the present context $_{57\,\mathrm{responses}}$

5. Curriculum having good academic flexibility to increase knowledge 57 responses




6. Course content fulfills the need of the students for his career $_{\rm 57\,responses}$







Going through the feedback report submitted by the teachers, it has been observed more than 65% of teachers strongly agreed that the curriculum is flexible and suitable for enrichment, revision and modification, based on recent trends and innovative ideas. Teachers' feedback report reflects the adequacy and availability of teaching-learning facilities, validity of the curriculum and reframing of the course content according to societal needs. The pandemic situation has taught us a lot. Now we are more user-friendly with technological gadgets. Our 80% of teachers are used digital platforms during their teaching-learning process. 84.2% of teachers are happy with the availability of relevant books in the library. Teachers

used digital resources for their student's upliftment and their enlightenment. 98.2% of teachers are also happy to fulfil the need of slow learners and they are aware enough of inclusiveness. Teachers also teach students about how to give differently-abled students a sense of equality.

D. Feedback form Alumni/ Industries. A google form is created to collect the feedback on the curriculum. Positive feedback is found that stakeholders are all satisfied with the content of the syllabus and curriculum and they have emphasized the inclusion of skill enhancement and more practical and applied parts of the subjects to be taught at the undergraduate level.

REDRESSAL MECHANISM

The outcomes achieved by the end of the year 2021- 22 and keeping this outcome in mind, the plan of action will be chalked out by the IQAC at the beginning of the academic year 2022-23. Feedback related to Academic Questions /Classes were discussed at the Departmental Level followed by Academic subcommittees in different meetings. The quality Enhancement Plan which was discussed in the meeting are discussed below:

PLAN OF ACTION TO BE TAKEN

- Plan to increase student involvement in community work for socialization and mental progress.
- A number of Add on and certificate Courses are to be introduced in various fields for the holistic development of our students.
- MOUs is to be signed for student's skill development with Industries so that students are aware of job-related training,
- Seminars, Workshops, and special lectures are to be organized by all departments to strengthen students, faculties and supporting staff.
- Arrange more smart and experiential leaning and approach to competitive exams are to be introduced.
- Starting Career Counselling Education Hub collaboration with National Academy are to be arranged for placements for students.
- Plan to arrange more motivational online/offline Value education programmes for students on mental well-being.
- To help undergraduate fresh students understand the challenges and opportunities present in the Institute and to counsel their academic and personal problems by 'Students

Mentoring System'.

- More industrial visits and field visits are to be conducted. Teachers are also asked to undertake more experiential teaching-learning processes.
- Slow learners and advanced learners are to be given more attention according to their needs.
- Bridge Courses and skill-oriented courses have been introduced to bridge the knowledge gap and to make students more skilled.
- Extension activities for social and environmental sensitization are to be conducted.
- More career guidance and soft skill development schemes have to be implemented for young learners.
- More faculty development programs have to be conducted to enrich the quality of teaching-learning.
